IEO also provides graduate and postgraduate education in collaboration with the University of Milan (<http://www.unimi.it>) and the European School of Molecular Medicine (SEMM: <http://www.semm.it>).

IEO has recently adopted an innovative organization, based on disease-oriented Multidisciplinary Programs, which host medical, surgical and research divisions, and are aimed at building integrated care pathways (prevention, diagnosis, cure and follow-up) and providing the most advanced standard and experimental therapies. The Hepatobiliary, Pancreatic and Digestive Program at IEO includes two Surgical Divisions (Division of Hepatobiliary and Pancreatic Surgery; Division of Abdominal Surgery), consisting of 10 General Surgeons. The Divisions provide specialized care in hepatobiliary and pancreatic surgery, colorectal surgery and upper GI surgery. DaVinci robotic and advanced laparoscopic equipment is available in the IEO operating rooms. Existing support services include exceptional diagnostic and interventional radiology.
