The foundation of Esagon arises from the pressing need for advanced post-graduate training, with a particular focus on the recent important progress in the field of oncologic surgery. The basis of the School curriculum will also include the integration of the different areas of expert surgical specialization (abdominal, gynecologic, urologic, and reconstructive surgeons) and an openness to innovations and changes brought about by technological breakthroughs.

Esagon's main characteristic is its international nature. The School will involve both institutions and individuals from different countries within the European Union and the rest of the world. The School's Faculty is composed of renowned experts both in the clinical and the research fields.

An innovative training process will progress from basic surgery through lectures and video presentations and then to live surgery. It therefore reaches the most advanced levels in surgery, taking into great consideration the accuracy of clinical assessment and close interdisciplinary collaboration. This leads to the ability of the trainee to manage more and more complex cases.

Continuous attention will be given to new scientific needs deriving from the integration of the different disciplines, e.g. minimally-invasive endoscopic and laparoscopic procedures, robotic surgery, new generation intra-operative imaging, nuclear medicine techniques, and intra-operative radiotherapy, all within a specialized approach to the discipline of oncologic surgery.
