

Internal Education and Training (check WR-E)

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The **2007 Scientific Internal Educational Program** was administered to 1.193 people involving a total amount of 985 Training hours and 606 Ministry of Health credit points awarded.

The Program included topics of general interest in oncology (Grand Rounds :6 credit points to 47 people); on Health, safety and quality in IEO (6 c.p to 21 people) and monthly orientation courses for new employees.

More specifically courses to all those personnel involved in patient management (physicians, medical radiology and laboratory technicians, biologists, physics, speech therapists, pharmacists, dietists, physiotherapists) were held in Medical Oncology (6 c.p. to 20 people); Head and Neck Oncology (58 c.p. to 33 people); Pathology (34 c. p. to 35 people); Haemato-oncology (68c.p. to 129 people); Chemoprevention (7 c.p. to 6 people); Medical Radiology and Nuclear Medicine (33 c.p. to 100 people); Chest Surgery (133 c.p. to 152 people); Radiotherapy (16 c.p. to 56 people); Pharmacy (8 c.p. to 11 people); Melanoma (14 c.p. to 8 people); Cardiology (20 c.p. to 36 people); Chemoprevention (26 c.p. to 3 people); Anesthesiology (12 c.p. to 26 people); General Surgery (15 c.p. to 35 people); Epidemiology (10 c.p. to 20 people); Basic Life Support and Defibrillation (5 c.p. to 77 people).

Courses were also held on topics of interest to nurses particularly in Haemato-oncology (22 c.p. to 17 nurses), Endoscopy (4c.p. to 12 nurses), Oncological Urology (6 c.p to 19 nurses); Senology (3 c.p to 38 nurses); in Safety and clinical risk management (7 c.p. to 5 nurses); in Management of antitiblastic drugs (4 c.p. to 13 nurses); in Toxicity of new drugs (4 c.p to 26 nurses).

The **2008 Internal Education Program** will include all the previous courses.

Moreover courses will be held in Reconstructive Surgery and Health Management.
