Attività clinica e di ricerca

Fedro Peccatori è medico oncologo, specialista in Oncologia Medica e in Ostetricia e Ginecologia. La sua attività clinica include principalmente la diagnosi e il trattamento del carcinoma mammario, dei tumori maligni ginecologici e dei tumori dei giovani adulti. E' Direttore dell'Unità Fertilità e Procreazione in Oncologia presso il Programma di Ginecologia dell'Istituto Europeo di Oncologia (IEO), Milano. Ha fatto parte del Dipartimento di Medicina e Oncologia Medica fino al 2014, quando sono stati istituiti in IEO i programmi multidisciplinari per patologia ed è diventato referente Oncologo del Programma di Ginecologia. I suoi principali progetti di ricerca comprendono la preservazione della fertilità nelle pazienti oncologiche, la protezione farmacologica della funzione ovarica durante chemioterapia, la caratterizzazione molecolare e clinica dei tumori mammari diagnosticati in gravidanza e protocolli di trattamento farmacologico dei tumori della mammella e ginecologici. In passato si è interessato di ricerca e cura delle neoplasie ematologiche, del trattamento dei linfomi maligni e di trapianto di cellule staminali periferiche autologhe e allogeniche nei tumori solidi e leucemie. E' stato responsabile insieme alla dottoressa Cristiana Sessa del progetto "Nuovi Farmaci" all'Istituto Europeo di Oncologia nel 1997, stabilendo le connessioni internazionali attraverso SENDO (Southern Europe New Drug Organization), di cui era membro, che hanno poi portato alla implementazione della Unità e successivamente della Divisione Nuovi Farmaci. Come ex presidente di PROFERT ha contribuito a costruire la rete italiana di conservazione della fertilità per i pazienti affetti da cancro. E' Direttore Scientifico della European School of Oncology (ESO), dove è incaricato di organizzare e corsi internazionali e masterclass su diversi problemi oncologici.




