- Diagnosis of rupture and durability of silicone gel breast implants. Study conducted in collaboration with Milan Polytechnic.
- Use of lipofilling technique (autologous fat transplantation) to repair the breast after quadrantectomy or mastectomy.
- Use of acellular dermal matrices of animal origin in addition to breast reconstruction with implants after mastectomy.
- Development of new surgical techniques "oncoplastic".
- Development of new gynecological reconstruction techniques due to an extensive demolition for tumor.
