

BEACON CANCER CARE, A MULTINATIONAL RESEARCH PROJECT TO REDUCE CANCER DISPARITIES ACROSS EUROPE



OVERVIEW:

A mobile app will inform patients, healthcare providers, researchers and policymakers about cancer care options available in Europe

TEXT:

The Cancer Care Beacon project is a European project coordinated by Prof. **Gabriella Pravettoni** Director of the Psycho-oncology Division at IEO. This project aims at identifying and then reducing disparities in cancer care across Europe. A team of psychologists, oncologists, data scientists and policymakers from different European countries is mapping the main capacities and capabilities of cancer centres in Europe with respect to the prevention, diagnosis and treatment of cancer disease.

Not only that, the project will create a decision-support mobile application to inform **patients** with respect to available treatment options across Europe, to make **healthcare providers** able to share resources and expertise, to make **researchers** aware of existing data on disparities, and to facilitate **policymakers** in aligning funding allocation with patients' priorities.
