# Introduction

Recently, the management of endometrial carcinoma has undergone a profound evolution, driven by the integration of molecular parameters in classification, new therapeutic evidence, and a substantial change in international guidelines.

In this dynamic context, the congress "The New Era in Endometrial Carcinoma Management: From Guidelines to Applicable Diagnostic and Therapeutic Pathways" is proposed as a moment of high-level update and comparison, with a program that integrates advanced diagnostic aspects and innovative therapeutic perspectives.

The chosen format, which alternates between interactive clinical cases and lectures based on the latest international evidence, will allow participants not only to acquire up-to-date knowledge, but also to engage directly with nationally and internationally recognized experts in a truly multidisciplinary perspective.

The congress will be divided into two days: the first part, in English, will be mainly dedicated to updates on ESGO guidelines, surgical approaches and histopathological and molecular framing; the second part, in Italian, will focus on systemic treatments, new molecules and management of emerging toxicities.

The added value of the event is represented by the participation of speakers of the highest scientific profile and the opportunity for direct and constructive discussion among professionals involved in the care of the patient with endometrial cancer.
